The Hungarian Charity Service of the Order of Malta has been present
at the Taban community in Monor since 2003. The Presence programme
has reached outstanding results through the enduring work over the past
years, so it is not by chance that it is beginning to be considered a model
programme. A workgroup from the Faculty of Architecture of the Budapest
University of Technology and Economics joined the work in 2012 in order to
provide architectural help to solve the problems of the community. Thanks
to the cooperation we hope that the future plans will be achieved according
to a well-thought and reasonable concept. One of the main aims of the long
and slow process is to construct a larger building with communal functions
on the Hangar estate. In the past few months two smaller garden buildings
have been built as the introductory and experimental first step of the long-
term more serious project of building the communal house.

The plans of the pavilion were designed by the group of architects together
with university students. A few of the most essential purposes of building
this house are the activity itself of building together, building the community,
teaching and learning. The function of the pavilion is to serve as an open-air,
covered area with a small shed attached. The community is characterized by
spending a lot of time outside to chat and to participate in communal activi-
ties and this small roof-construction wishes to be the quality stage for these
activities. For the execution of the construction the financial background
was provided by an American grant (Alumni Engagement Innovation Found
2013, Department of State, American Embassy Budapest) won by the work-
group of architects and by a Hungarian grant (Hungarian Academy of Arts).
